Dear LA School of Gymnastics Summer Day Camp Parents:

Thank you for enrolling your child in the award winning summer gymnastics day camp program. We are delighted to provide a quality experience for you and your child and look forward to a fantastic summer! Enclosed you will find helpful hints that will enhance your child's experience during his/her participation in the 2019 Summer Gymnastics Day Camp program:

Gymnastics Portion – 9am-12pm Daily

Students will be placed in groups based on age and ability via the Camp Director based on your child's start date. The instructor will establish placement of your child's group at the conclusion of morning warm-up between 9am-10:30am. Each child will have the opportunity to work on all our various apparatus and work with different LASG coaches learning from the top instructors in Los Angeles the basic and progressive development of gymnastics for both men's and women's gymnastics introduction through advanced levels.

Snack/Lunch

All students will need to bring a **snack** or payment to ensure they have sufficient nutrition for the activities scheduled for each day. Students participating in a full day program (9am-3pm) will need to bring a lunch or may purchase a lunch for \$8.00.*Kids tend to get hungry and thirsty so please provide enough food to sustain them throughout the day and consider purchasing at our gift shop or vending services two drinks *and* a water bottle. (Gatorade, fruit juice, water bottles, granola bars, trail mix etc. are good options and can be purchased or brought to the day camp). A

refrigerator/freezer is available however we do not allow microwave use at the facility.

Wednesday is Pool Day

Every Wednesday we will be traveling to a local Swim Center via school bus. This is an exciting but short trip allocated to Wed afternoons only. This will be the only off-site activity and we have very strict policies to uphold for all Wed swim programs and appreciate your cooperation in advance. We ask that you have your child bring a swimsuit, towel, and sunscreen with his/her name clearly marked on each item. LASG is not responsible for misplaced or lost items. A lost and found is available at the Swim Center and LASG offices. We encourage all levels of swimmers and all ages! **All children will swim in shallow water** and will only be permitted in deep water with parental approval *and* **LA County Lifeguard** swim test. This event is supervised by LASG counselors and LA County lifeguard employees with a strict student teacher ratio to ensure the highest caliber of safety. On Wed, please pack your child's swim bag with an LASG Camp T-shirt, it may be purchased for \$15.00 at the gift shop.

* All 3rd party voucher purchases: LASG T-shirt is not included in the base day camp program. Camp Shirt: \$15.00

Special Concerns

Please notify us if your child has any special needs (allergies, asthma etc.). LASG does not administer medication unless provided and accompanied with a physician's statement of necessity as provided by law.

Cell Phones & Communication

Cell phones are NOT allowed at the LA School of Gymnastics Day Camp program. We kindly ask that cell phones are not brought to the school or will be held by staff members at the front office. If you have an emergency, please contact our offices at 310-204-1980. Please make sure the gym has current contact phone numbers for you including work, home, mobile and emergency contacts.

Late care

LASG does not offer any grace period after 3 pm, anything after 3 is considered late care. Late care fee is \$15.00 per hour. Please arrive a few minutes early to avoid late care fee.

Refund Policy

Please carefully choose and secure your child's day camp dates, times and schedule. Camp programs operate on limited space, specialized and highly trained staff. Camp is non-refundable, non-transferable and your preferred dates of attendance must be confirmed prior to your start date. Deadline for confirmed dates of attendance is: June 1, 2019. LASG is not responsible for lost or stolen items and a Lost & Found is available at the camp facilities.

All voucher based programs must have paperwork, application and confirmation of dates by June 1, 2013. Transfer of dates are not eligible for voucher programs in any capacity.
